

The map has altitude colouring (bands in metres: 50, 200, 500, 1000, 2000, 3000, 5000 plus glaciers) and spot heights. National Parks are highlighted. Road network includes selected local track. Symbols indicate various places of interest including campsites, religious temples, etc. Also shown are the countrys internal administrative boundaries with names of the provinces. The map is indexed and has latitude and longitude lines at intervals of 30. The inset plan of Thimpu indicates locations of selected hotels, places of interest, etc. and is indexed for streets and points of interest. A more general plan of the Paro area shows roads, including access to the airport, and is indexed for points of interest and public buildings. The map is double-sided, the reverse features a travel map of Northern India at scale 1:2,100,000.
