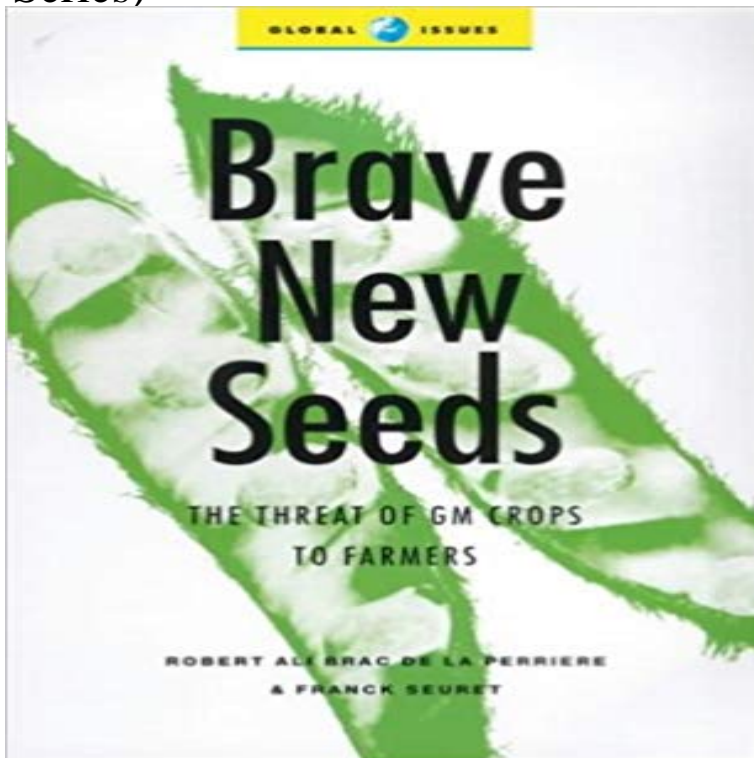


Brave New Seeds: The Threat of GM Crops to Farmers (Global Issues Series)
