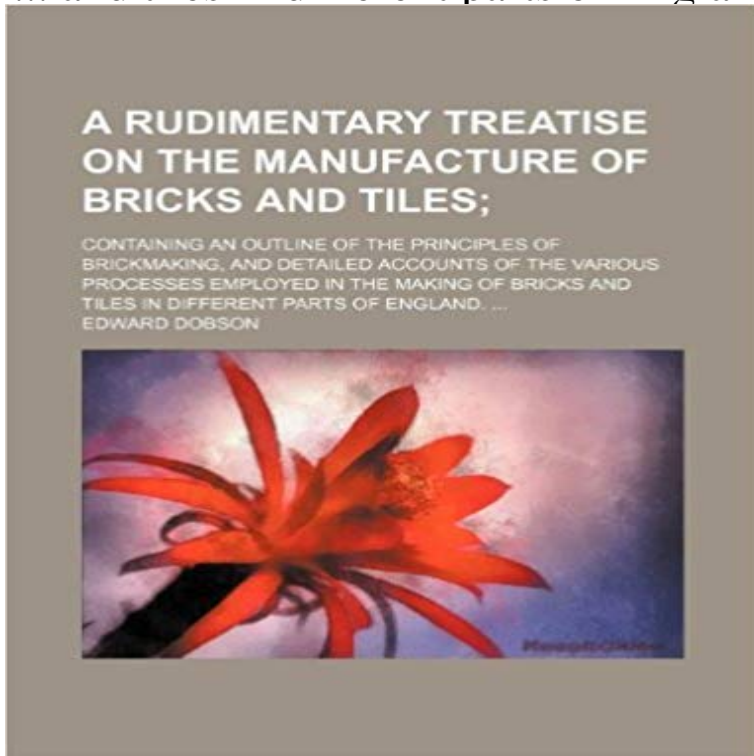

Not illustrated. 1850 Excerpt: ...and require replating from time to time. The expense of replating with brass has induced a trial of iron rims, but they have not been found to answer. The outside of the mould is cased with wood, secured to the brass by the rivets. To give a hold to the latter, each pair is passed through a piece of sheet copper, as shown in the cut. The moulds for making quarries are somewhat different, two of the sides only being cased with wood, whilst the others are stiffened by strengthening ribs cast on the sides of the mould. Fig. 8. The five-brick lining to the fire-holes is indicated in the plan by a tint darker than that of the rest of the walls. The temporary piers of brickwork are shown in outline only. These are pulled down whenever the fire-brick lining requires to be renewed. The floor of the kiln is not paved. Kg. 13.
