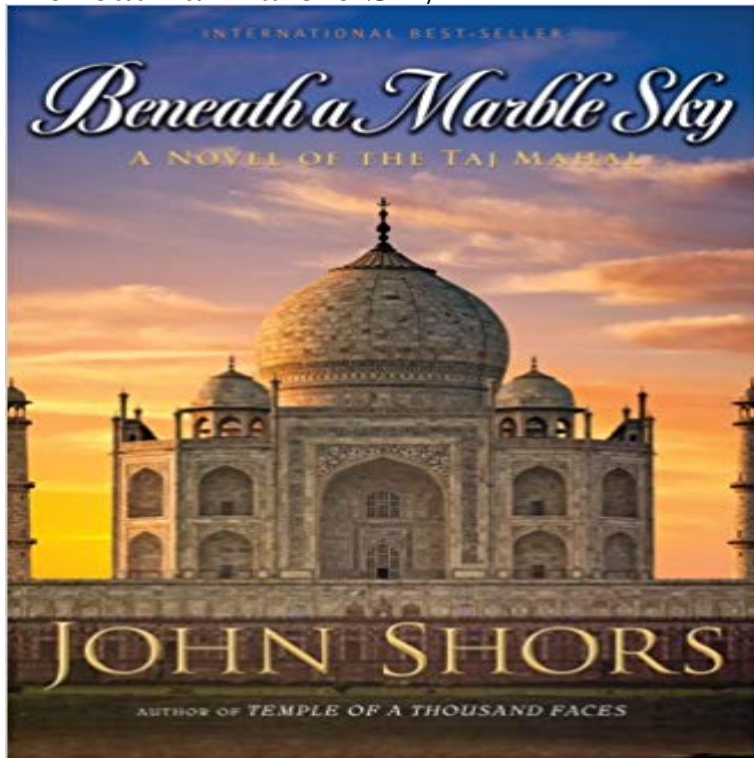


## Beneath a Marble Sky
