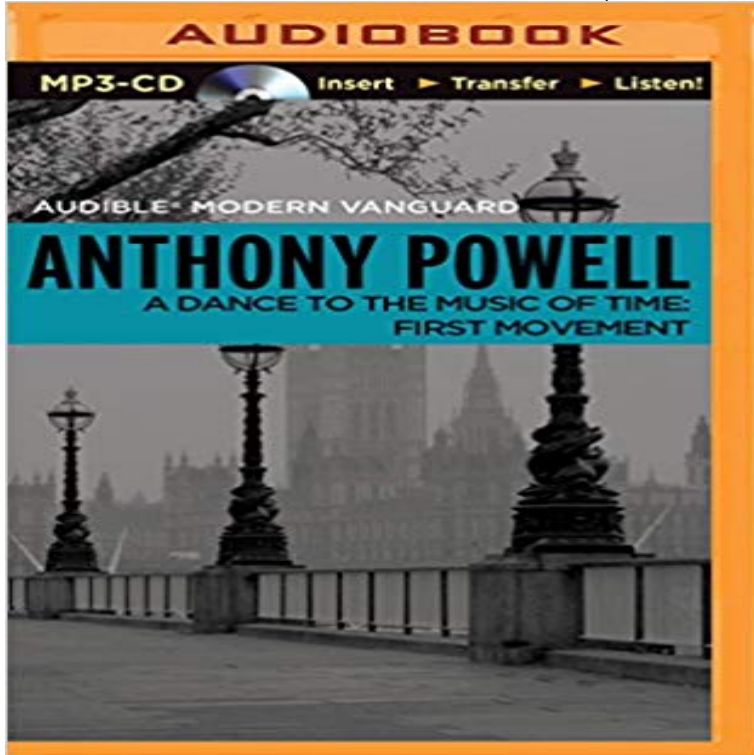


A Dance to the Music of Time, First Movement
