

South West Indian Ocean Fisheries Commission. Report of the third session of the Scientific Committee: Maputo, Mozambique, 16-19 September 2008 (FAO Fisheries and Aquaculture Reports)



The Scientific Committee examined the status of fisheries resources in its area of competence; considered the report of the second Working Party on Fisheries Data and Statistics; discussed a recent fishery assessment from Mauritius; discussed management and research actions in Mozambique (lobster), Seychelles (sharks), South Africa (line fishery) and Tanzania (prawns); discussed the preparation of next years conference on the contribution of fisheries to the Millennium Development Goals; discussed the results of a workshop on ecosystem approach to fisheries; encouraged the formation of informal working groups to address priority areas identified; and made recommendations for the consideration of the fourth session of the Commission.
