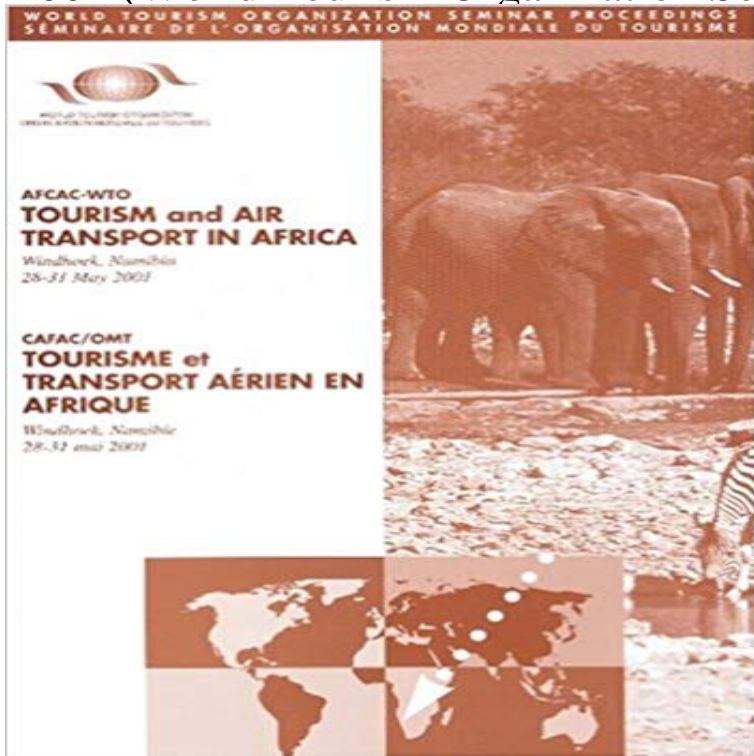


# Tourism and Air Transport in Africa: Windhoek, Namibia, 28-31 May 2001 (World Tourism Organization Seminar Proceedings)
