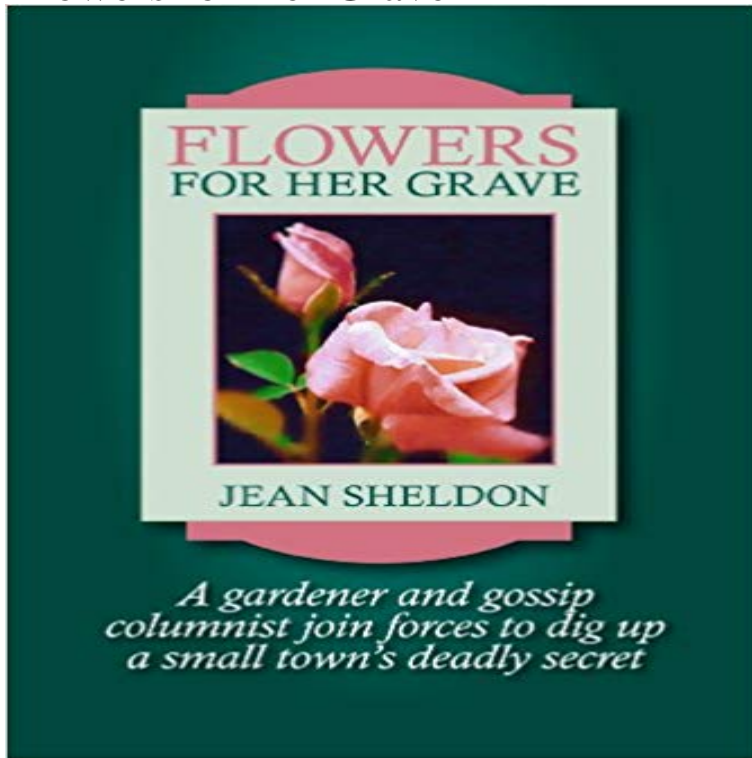


# Flowers for Her Grave
