

In *Hurricanes Anonymous* first included in the *Best American Short Stories* anthology a young man searches for the mother of his son in a Louisiana devastated by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. *George Orwell Was a Friend of Mine* follows a former warden of a Stasi prison in East Germany who vehemently denies his past, even as pieces of it are delivered in packages to his door. And in the unforgettable title story,

Johnson returns to his signature subject, North Korea, depicting two defectors from Pyongyang who are trying to adapt to their new lives in Seoul, while one cannot forget the woman he left behind.
