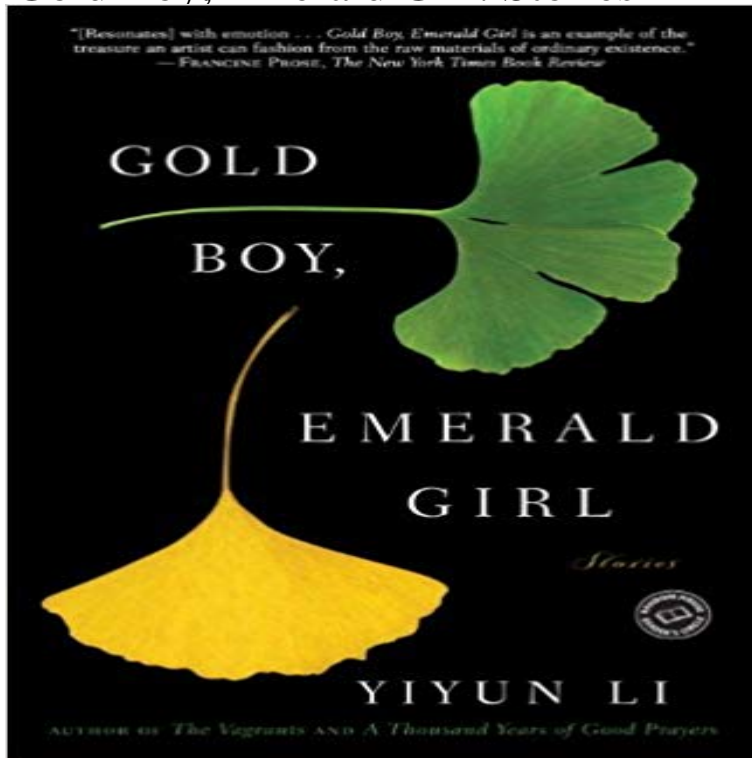


Gold Boy, Emerald Girl: Stories
