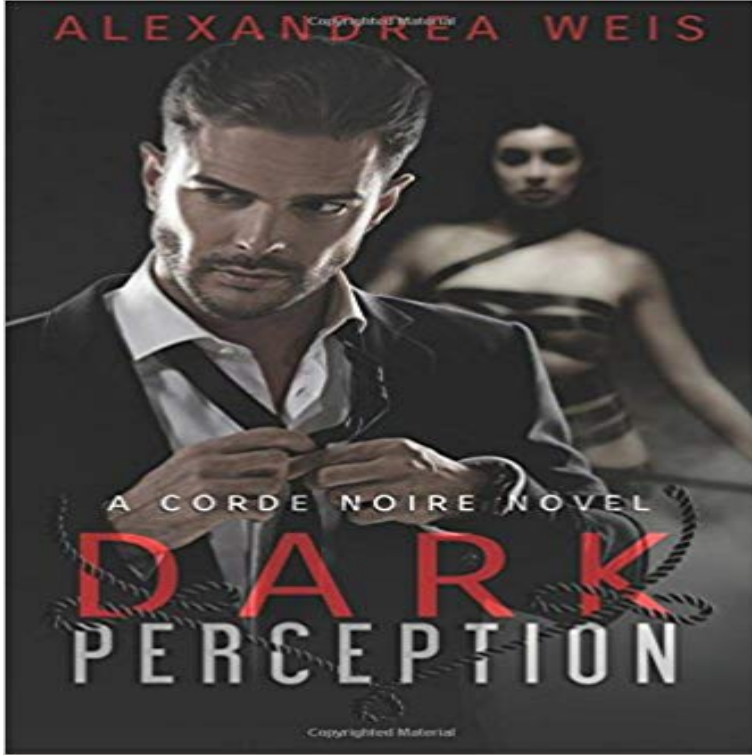


Dark Perception: The Corde Noire Series (Volume 1)
