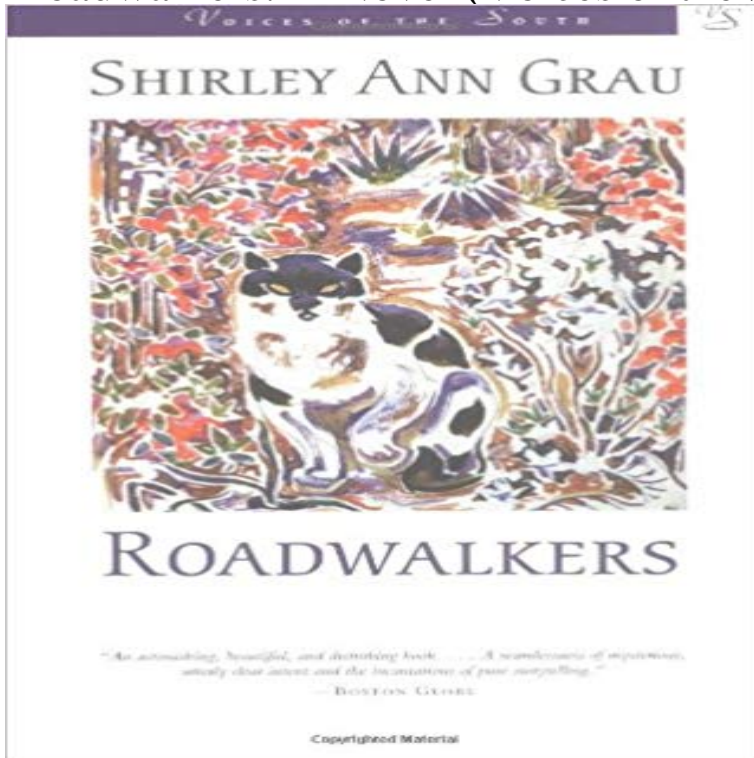


Roadwalkers: A Novel (Voices of the South)
