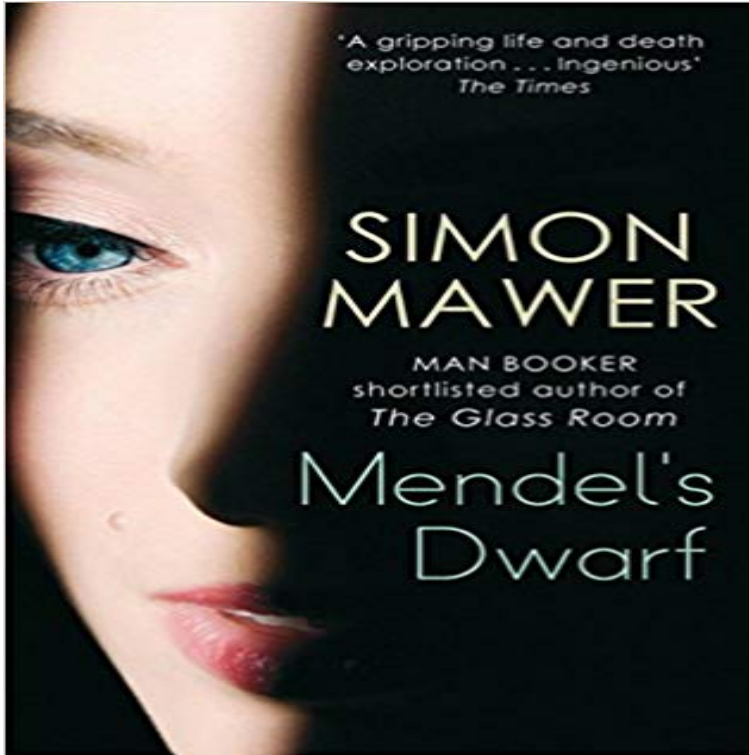


Mendels Dwarf
