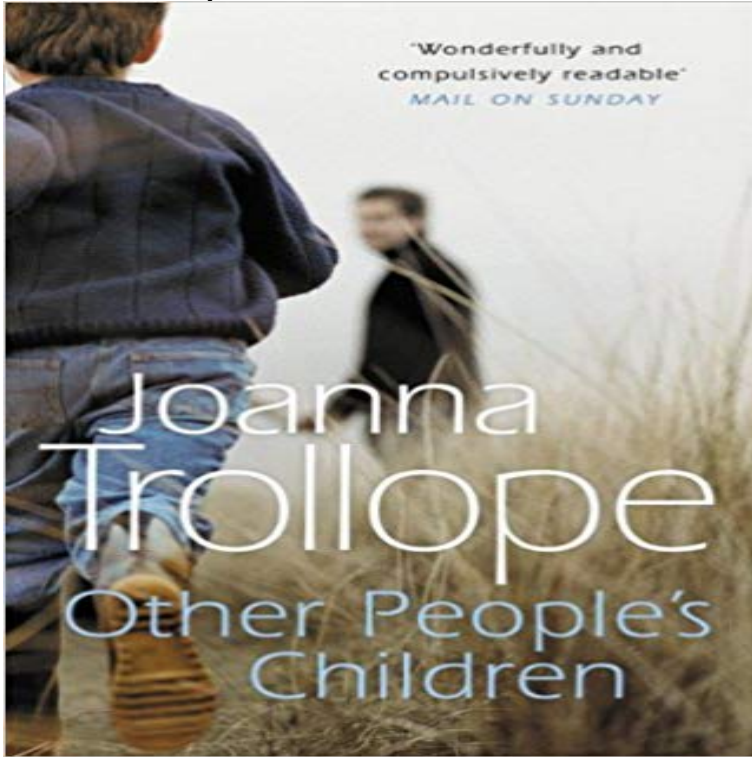


## Other Peoples Children
