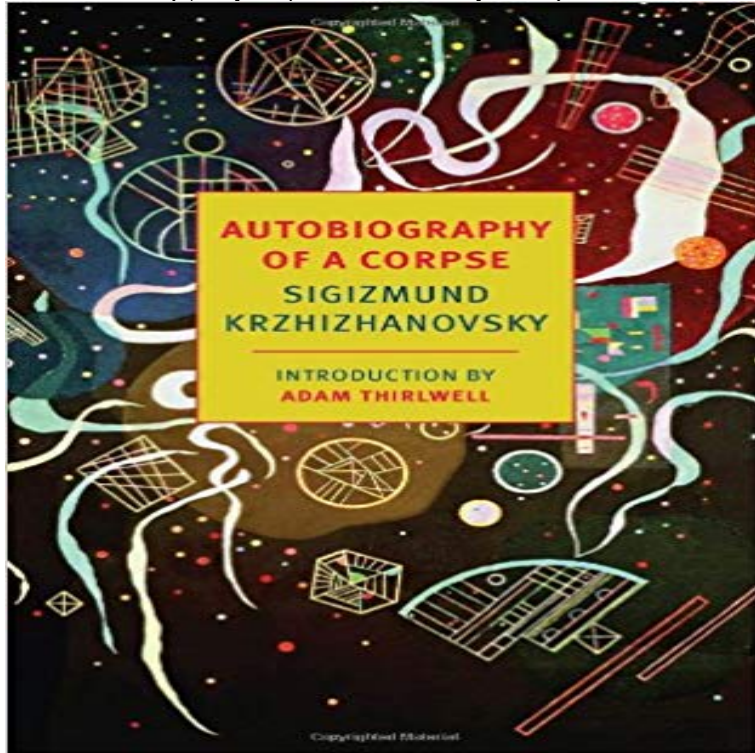


Autobiography of a Corpse (New York Review Books Classics)
