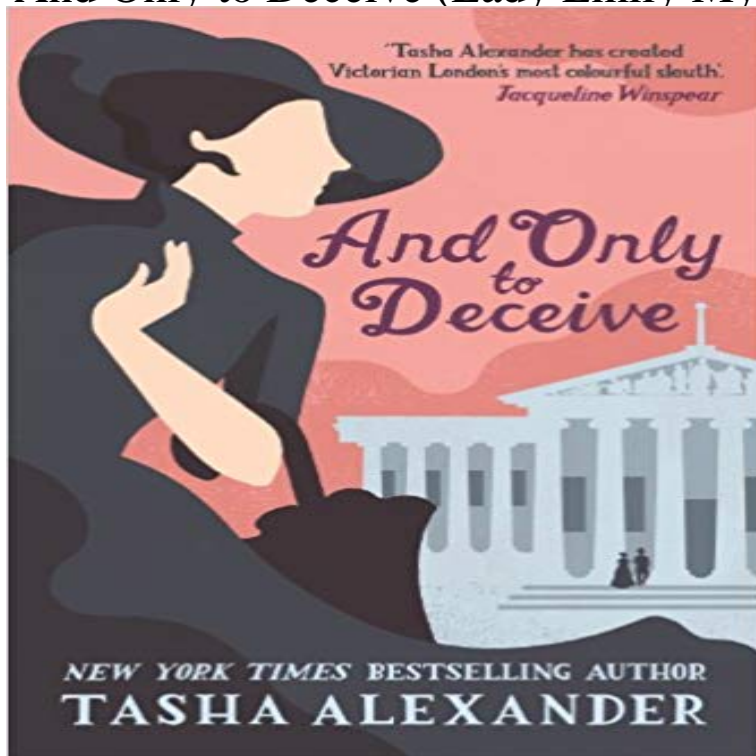


And Only to Deceive (Lady Emily Mysteries)
