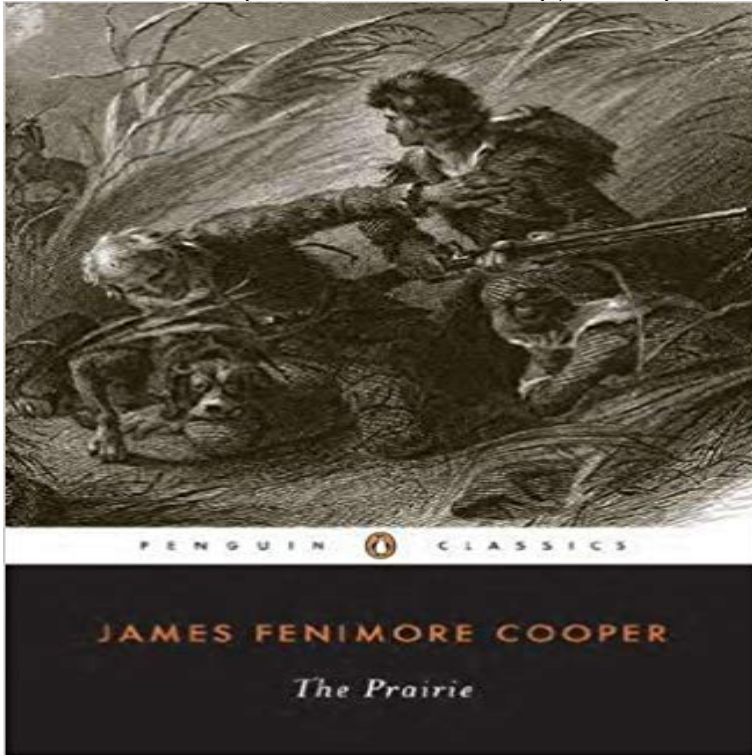


The Prairie (Leatherstocking Tale)
