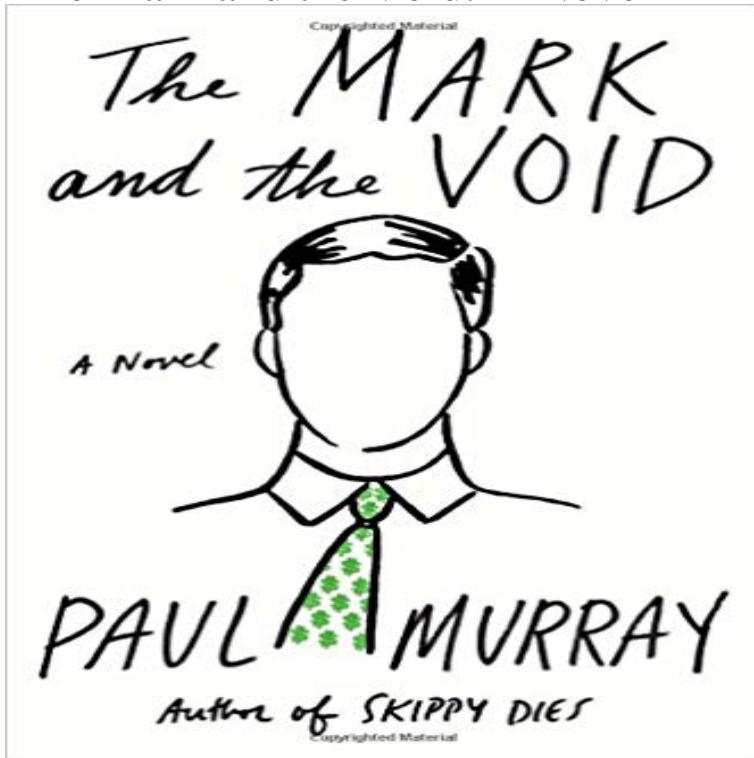


The Mark and the Void: A Novel
