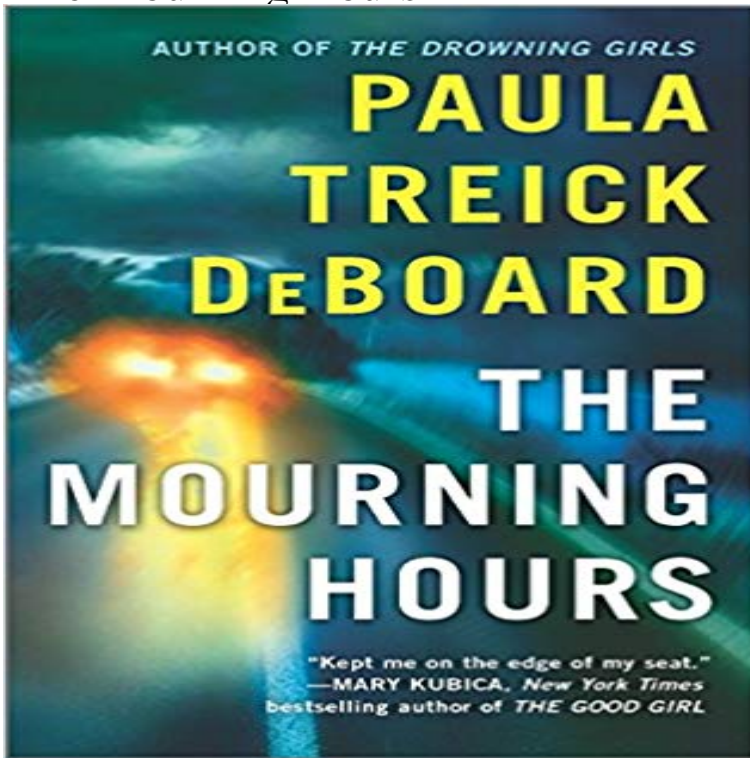


The Mourning Hours
