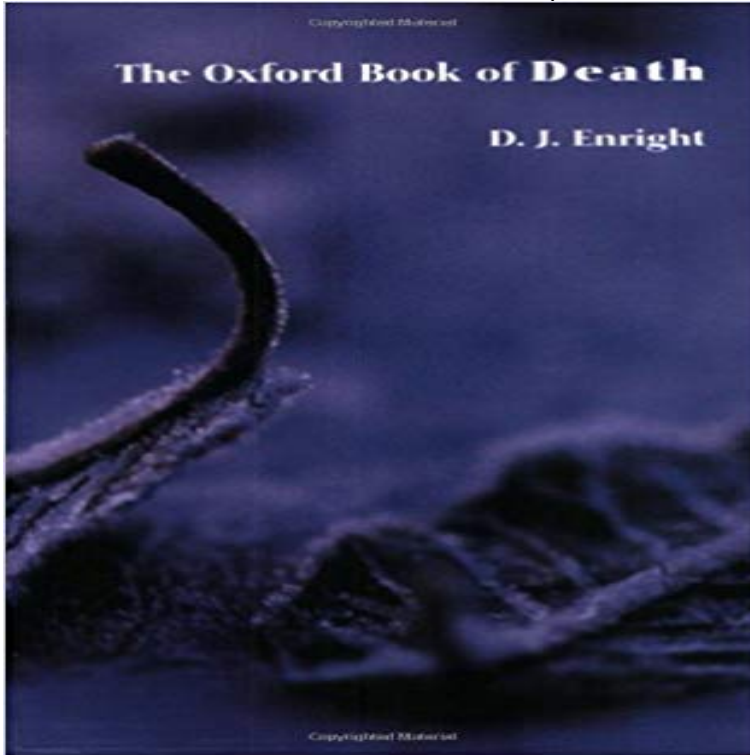


# The Oxford Book of Death (Oxford Books of Prose)
