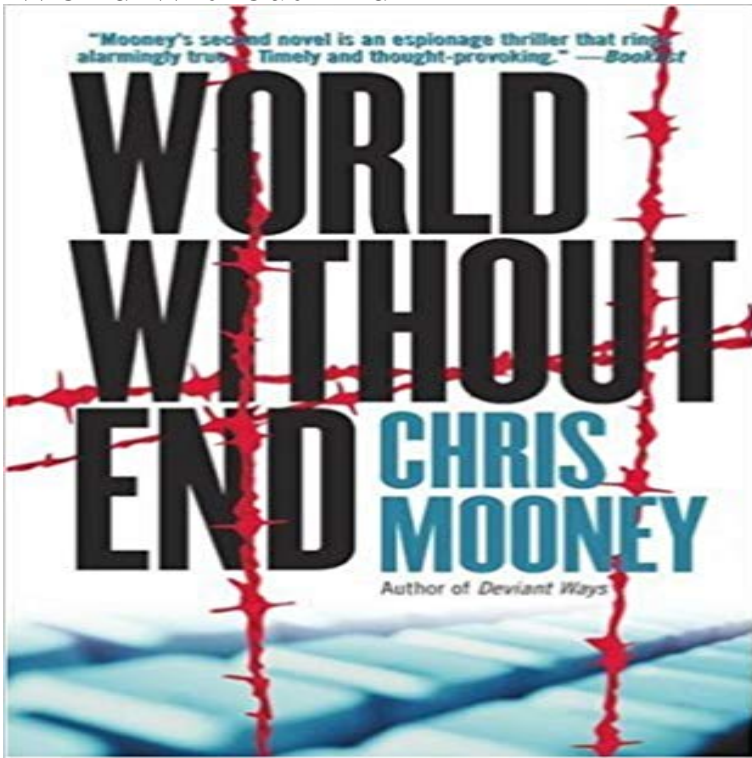


World Without End
